

Privacy Policy

Savage Hosting Ltd. is committed to respecting privacy of customers and users of the Savage Hosting website.

This privacy policy governs the manner in which Savage Hosting, Ltd. (Savage Hosting) uses, maintains and discloses information collected from customers and users of the Savage Hosting Website.

Privacy

Savage Hosting is committed to developing long lasting relationships based on trust. Savage Hosting will do everything in its power to ensure that your right to privacy is maintained and protected. This Website is not directed at children under 13 years of age.

Information Savage Hosting Collect

Savage Hosting may request or collect personal information from online users in a variety of ways, including through online forms for ordering products and services, and other instances where users are invited to volunteer such information. The information Savage Hosting collects is personal information that identifies you personally, such as:

- Your name
- E-mail address
- Postal address
- Telephone and facsimile numbers
- URL

Savage Hosting may also collect information on how users access the Website by using a tracking ID unique to each user through the use of cookies.

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's computer tied to information about the user. Savage Hosting may use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. For session ID cookies, once you close your browser or log out, the cookie terminates and is erased. A persistent cookie is a small text file stored on your computer's hard drive for an extended period of time. Your browser's help file contains information and instructions for removing persistent cookies. Session ID cookies may be used by Savage Hosting to track user preferences while the user is visiting the website. They also help to minimise load times and save on server processing. Persistent cookies may be used by Savage Hosting to store, for example, whether or not you want your email address remembered, or other such information. Cookies used on the Savage Hosting Website do not contain personally identifiable information.

Log Files

Like most standard Websites, Savage Hosting uses log files. This information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp, and number of clicks to analyse trends, administer the site, track user's movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use.

How Savage Hosting uses this information

Savage Hosting may use the personally identifiable information collected by Savage Hosting to contact users regarding products and services offered by Savage Hosting but **only** if the user has "opted in" to this agreement. It will not allow its trusted affiliates, independent contractors or business partners to contact you whether you have agreed to being contacted by Savage Hosting or not. Savage Hosting holds a strict no "spam" policy. If the user has not asked for information from Savage Hosting or opted in to an agreement, Savage Hosting will not contact them in any way. Savage Hosting may also use this information for research purposes regarding the effectiveness of Website services, marketing, advertising and sales efforts. Savage Hosting will not in any way share this information with a third party either for free or by selling it, unless you specifically authorise such disclosures.

Disclosure of Information

Savage Hosting may also disclose aggregate, anonymous, data based on information collected from Users to investors and potential partners. In such cases, statistical information only will be disclosed and personally identifiable data will be kept strictly confidential. In case Savage Hosting is sold, the information collected from users may be transferred to the new owners.

Savage Hosting may from time to time engage third parties, including its own subsidiaries and affiliated companies, to preserve, analyse or otherwise store or manipulate data received by Savage Hosting from its users. In all such cases, such third party service providers will be required to treat all such data with the same degree of care as Savage Hosting and they will be prohibited from disclosing such data to any other person or party, except as otherwise provided for in this Privacy Policy.

Special Offers and Updates

Savage Hosting customers and users will occasionally receive information on products, services, special deals, and possibly a newsletter, if they have "opted in".

Service Announcements

On rare occasions it is necessary to send out a strictly service related announcement, if, for instance, a service is temporarily suspended for maintenance. This is an opt-out only communication, as information about this will be strictly important and relevant to the customer. These communications are not promotional in nature.

Legal Disclaimer

Though every effort is made to preserve your privacy, Savage Hosting may need to disclose personal information when required to by law or as part of an investigation. If it is deemed necessary that such action needs to be taken, Savage Hosting will comply with judicial proceedings should a court order or legal process be served on Savage Hosting.

The Savage Hosting Website contains links to other sites. Please be aware that Savage Hosting is not responsible for the privacy practices of such other sites. You are encouraged to read the privacy statements of each and every Web site that collects personally identifiable information. The Savage Hosting Privacy Policy as described herein applies solely to information collected by Savage Hosting.

Maintenance of Information

The information provided to Savage Hosting is saved indefinitely and may be stored on one or more databases directly or indirectly maintained by Savage Hosting. Savage Hosting employs industry standard security measures to protect the confidentiality of the information. Although Savage Hosting cannot guarantee that any loss, misuse or alteration of data will not occur; every effort is made to prevent such occurrences. Any other particularly sensitive information, such as payment details collected for commercial transactions, is encrypted prior to transmission by you to Savage Hosting.

Your Responsibility

You are responsible for the security of your Account Number and passwords, when applicable. Make sure you keep it in a safe place and do not share it with others.

Always remember to log out after your session ends, to ensure that others cannot access your private personal information. You should take this precaution even if you are not using a public computer, such as at work or internet café, but even when using your private computer in your home.
